Background:

On- going conflict and instability in Iraq and Syria has triggered acute demographic destabilization with increasing numbers of refugees and internally displaced persons (IDPs), further increasing vulnerability. In the recent years Iraq has seen a resurgence of large- scale displacement of people affected by the conflict. The overall impact on the lives of displaced populations fleeing violence is immeasurable and the task to rebuild their lives and restore their livelihoods will take decades and they remain highly vulnerable unable to restore their lives and livelihoods, as well as in constant fear facing persistent insecurity and the chance they will have to flee once again. Within this context, women and girls are particularly vulnerable to security threats and are unable to claim their rights and are in need of additional support to protect them from rights violations such as sexual and gender based violence (SGBV) committed both within family and outside.
