1. Introduction

The International Committee of the Red Cross is an independent, neutral organization ensuring humanitarian protection and assistance for victims of war and other situations of violence.

The ICRC intends to transport (28) Eight of its vehicles by 14 x 40' containers (size of containers given in paragraph 2. Carrying two vehicles each), from Iraq via Umm Qasr port in Basra, Iraq to Jebel Ali Free Zone / Dubai / UAE, as mentioned in the below table and is hereby requesting a tender from your company for the Cost of Transport and Export Processing Fees (ICRC is exempted from customs duties and will provide relevant document and export permit).

The vehicles should be shipped by 40'' ft standard size containers, with very strong stuffing and lashing.

4. Price and Payment terms

Payment terms

The total amount will be paid by bank transfer to the Agent's Bank Account in once in US Dollar within 14 banking days after delivering the vehicles safely to the consignee in Jabal Ali Free Zone/UAE., and after receiving the invoice from the transporter with 3/3 original / copies of 'shipped on board' bills of lading.

Receipt of the Eight (28) ICRC vehicles from the first carrier at Umm Qasr port, then vehicles to be Containerized/stuffed, safely lashed, shipped and delivered at Jabal Ali Free Zone to the below mentioned consignee.

The Agent will bear all risks and responsibilities of losing or damaging of the shipped vehicles during the above mentioned processes.

6. Penalty Clause

Failure by Agent to avail the transportation according to mentioned date will result in the transporter being penalized with a 1% reduction of the value of the undelivered vehicles per day of delay up to a maximum of 10 % of the total value of the contract.
