SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION

The IRP2-Ta'afi and DCEO-Tahfeez Projects are USAID funded programs implemented by Chemonics Iraq LLC and Sama Al Tatawer for General Trade LLC in Iraq. The goal of the IRP2-Ta'afi and DCEO-Tahfeez Projects is to assist and support Iraqi people and the Government of Iraq. As part of project activities, the IRP2-Ta'afi and DCEO-Tahfeez Projects require the purchase of security services.

This document is soliciting Expressions of Interest (EOI) for BPA for Security Services that meet the eligibility requirements defined herein and have experience working in one or more of the technical areas and locations outlined in Section 3.

Interested Parties are invited to submit their response in accordance with Section 2 (Instructions). A submittal of a response serves as notice to Chemonics of the Party's general interest in participating in the RFQ for BPA of security services for IRP2-Ta'afi and DCEO-Tahfeez Projects. Responses will be used to confirm eligibility for Requests for Quotation, regarding the Project's future security services. However, a submittal of a response does not guarantee that the Interested Party will be contacted to perform any services. Activities that are listed in Section 3 are illustrative only; Chemonics may or may not conduct similar activities under the Project.

SECTION 2: INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Submittal Deadline

Expressions of interest must be received by mail no later than 17:00 hrs. local Iraq time on November 15, 2023. Late submittals will be considered at the discretion of the Project.

2.2 Protocol for Submission of Submittals and Required Documents

Respondents are responsible for ensuring that their submittals are received in accordance with the instructions stated herein.

All submittals must be prepared in the English language. The EOI must be submitted by email to solicitationsirp2@icritaafi.org with the subject line EOI No. IRP2-ERB-OPS-2023-053. **The EOI should include company registration in both Kurdistan Region and Federal Iraq from any individual company that is submitting EOI or from two companies where they submit EOI as a joint venture (each of them can be registered in one location, making them both have Kurdistan Region and Federal Iraq registration together) because Chemonics will need Mobile Security Team for cross border trips.**

Each respondent may submit only one EOI, either individually or as a partner in a joint venture or consortium. A respondent who submits or participates in more than one EOI per technical area shall cause all EOIs in that area with that respondent's participation to be disqualified.

2.3 Questions and Clarifications

All questions and/or clarifications regarding this EOI must be submitted via email to solicitationsirp2@icritaafi.org no later than 11:00 hrs. local Iraq time on November 13, 2023. All correspondence and/or inquiries regarding this solicitation must reference the EOI number. No phone

calls or in-person inquiries will be entertained; all questions and inquiries must be in writing.

Only the written answers will be considered official. Any verbal information received from a Chemonics or Project employees, or other entity, should not be considered as an official response to any questions regarding this EOI.

SECTION 3: CATEGORIES OF TECHNICAL SERVICES AND LOCATIONS

3.1 Objective

Chemonics, IRP2-Ta'afi Project, and DCEO-Tahfeez Project anticipate to issue an RFQ as a result of this EOI to solicit quotations from eligible security services providers licensed to operate in both Federal Iraq and Kurdish Region of Iraq for a variety of as-needed, ad hoc security services. As a result of the RFQ, Chemonics anticipates issuing multiple BPAs to establish specific pricing levels and parameters for ordering these services. This will allow Chemonics to issue specific purchase orders, on an as-needed basis, for the procurement of the services over the period of 12 months. The Supplier shall furnish the supplies/services described in any purchase orders issued by Chemonics under the BPA. Chemonics is only obligated to pay for services ordered through purchase orders issued under the BPA and delivered by the Supplier in accordance with the terms/conditions of the BPA.

3.2 Categories of Technical Services

The services that will be requested under the RFQ and the resulting BPA will be as follows:

- 1- Armed Mobile Security Team with Expat and Local National Team Leader
- 2- Unarmed Mobile Security Team with Expat and Local National Team Leader
- 3- Unarmed Soft Skin Mobile Security with Local National Driver
- 4- PSD Expat Medic
- 5- Armed Static Guarding Services including Guard Supervisor, Guard Shift Team Member/Male Searcher, Female Guard/Searcher, and Emergency Armoured Vehicle

3.3 Locations of Work

The locations where the security services including mobile and/or static security service are required are mainly the provinces of Erbil, Ninewa (including Sinjar), Anbar, Salahaddin, Baghdad (including International Zone), Dhi Qar, and Basrah.
