

Request for Proposal: Supply, Installation, and Commissioning of ICT Infrastructure for the Persons with Disabilities and Special Needs (PWDSN) Commission

Section	Content
Background	Introduction The Persons with Disabilities and Special Needs (PWDSN) program, overseen by the PWDSN commission under MOLSA, is a non-contributory social protection initiative in Iraq. This program is aimed at assisting caregivers of individuals with disabilities. Working closely with the Ministry of Health and another partner organization, the program currently supports approximately 232,715 beneficiaries, a number that continues to grow. These beneficiaries are caregivers who provide essential services to individuals with various disabilities across Iraq. Support is extended to caregivers following a disability assessment conducted by a medical committee from the Ministry of Health. This assessment verifies the nature and severity of the disability. The program covers a range of disabilities, including physical disabilities, hemophilia, visual impairments (blindness), autism, hearing impairments (deafness), schizophrenia, mental disabilities, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, short stature, thalassemia, and diabetic children (under 18). The PWDSN program offers multiple benefits and services to its beneficiaries. The most prominent service is the provision of caregivers. If the caregiver is a civil servant, they are eligible for a fully paid one-year leave, which can be renewed annually. Alternatively, caregivers who are unemployed or work in the private sector receive cash assistance determined by the relevant department. Prospective beneficiaries of the PWDSN program have the option to register either online or in person using a paper form. Once submitted, applications undergo a thorough review by the relevant department within the PWDSN Authority. Additionally, an external health committee, established for this specific purpose, evaluates the applications to ensure proper assessment.
	2. Project Vision The collaboration between the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the World Food Programme (WFP) represents a pioneering effort to bolster the Persons with Disabilities and Special Needs (PWDSN). This joint endeavor harnesses the extensive expertise of these distinguished entities to address the needs of vulnerable populations, with a particular emphasis on persons with disabilities. At the core of this initiative lies the development and execution of an advanced ICT infrastructure to be aligned with PWDSN authority endeavors to develop the Management Information System (MIS) that serves as a catalyst for enhancing the commission's services.
	3. ICT Infrastructure Current Profile Within its PWDSN headquarters located in Baghdad, which is part of a larger complex under the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs, the PWDSN Authority possesses a collection of small to medium-sized buildings. Additionally, the authority has established branches across all Iraqi governorates, excluding the Kurdistan region. Regrettably, the existing network infrastructure in place is characterized by its frailty and irregularity, lacking adherence to recognized standards or technological norms. The existing deployment of the PWDSN Management Information System (MIS) is fraught with security vulnerabilities as it relies on servers that possess restricted processing capabilities and storage capacities.

	This setup proves inadequate to accommodate any potential future expansions. Additionally, the PWDSN organization lacks functional data centers in the conventional sense. Currently, the PWDSN Authority operates within a confined space, housing a rack, UPS, and servers. These servers are primarily dedicated to hosting the PWDSN MIS. Notably, this setup is associated with limited network accessibility at the headquarters. Moreover, the server is directly linked to a restricted internet connection featuring a public IP address. This connection, although permitting other PWDSN branches to access the system, is characterized by its lack of security measures.															
Objectives, Purpose & Expected results	The project aims to enhance the management information system (MIS) of PWDSN’s programme by procuring necessary hardware and software components, strengthening network infrastructure, implementing robust data protection and cybersecurity measures, and improving the ICT skills of PWDSN staff. Therefore, the project encompasses two interrelated strategic categories: Objective 1: Enhance PWDSN ICT Infrastructure Readiness by procuring and deploying essential hardware and software components and strengthening network infrastructure. Objective 2: Ensure PWDSN Data Protection and Cybersecurity Implementation to protect sensitive data through the implementation of robust data protection and cybersecurity measures.															
Description of the assignment	Project Scope The project encompasses comprehensive endeavors across the following key domains: • Implementation of a PWDSN HQ DC hardware and software infrastructure. • Augmentation of PWDSN HQ network infrastructure to support enhanced data flows. • Rigorous implementation of data protection and cybersecurity measures PWDSN HQ. Timeline The project is anticipated to span a duration of 4 to 8 months, beginning with the supply and implementation. 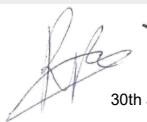
